- Meet with the Minister of Students, Chad Moore, and have him sign below.
- Return this agreement with all signatures to the Ministry Leader for final approval.

What We Expect

- Be an example. Lead by example while on and off campus in the spirit of 1 Timothy 4:12: "Let no one despise you for your youth, but set the believers an example in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith, in purity."
- Be dependable. If you cannot be here, let the Ministry Leader know either via phone or email prior to the scheduled service hour.
- Be honest. If you are struggling, please let us know and we will work together to come up with a solution.
- Be present. Do not use your cell phone while serving.
- Be focused. Do not bring friends along with you, as this can be a distraction.

What You Can Expect

- Regular communication from your Ministry Leader and scheduled responsibilities.
- Responsibility on par with adults and an opportunity to invest in the lives of others.
- The joy found in serving Christ humbly and an added piece to your walk with Christ.
- We will sign your service hours requirement for school.
