(Required for any 6-12th grade student desiring to serve on Sundays)

Areas to Serve

Requirements

- Must be in 6th-12th grade.
- Be actively involved in your Student Ministry Life Group (no less than 50% attendance each quarter).
- Meet with the appropriate Ministry Leader from one of the areas listed above and have them sign below.
- Review this form with your parents and have them sign.
- Meet with the Minister of Students, Chad Moore, and have him sign below for final approval.

What We Expect

- Be an example -- Lead by example while on and off campus in the spirit of 1 Timothy 4:12: "Let no one despise you for your youth, but set the believers an example in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith, in purity."
- Be dependable -- Be in place and on time as expected. If you cannot be here, let the Ministry Leader know either via phone or email prior to the scheduled service hour.
- Be candid -- If you are struggling with an aspect of what you're doing, please let us know and we will work together to come up with a solution.
- Be present -- You're playing an important part in this ministry, so be present. Limit distractions and stay off your phone while you're serving. If a friend drops by, politely ask them to let you focus on serving.

What You Can Expect

- The ministry may have an additional contract or requirements specific to that ministry.
- Regular communication from your Ministry Leader and scheduled responsibilities.
- Responsibility on par with adults and an opportunity to invest in the lives of others.
- The joy found in serving Christ humbly and an added component to your walk with Christ.
- We will sign your service hours requirement for school if asked.
